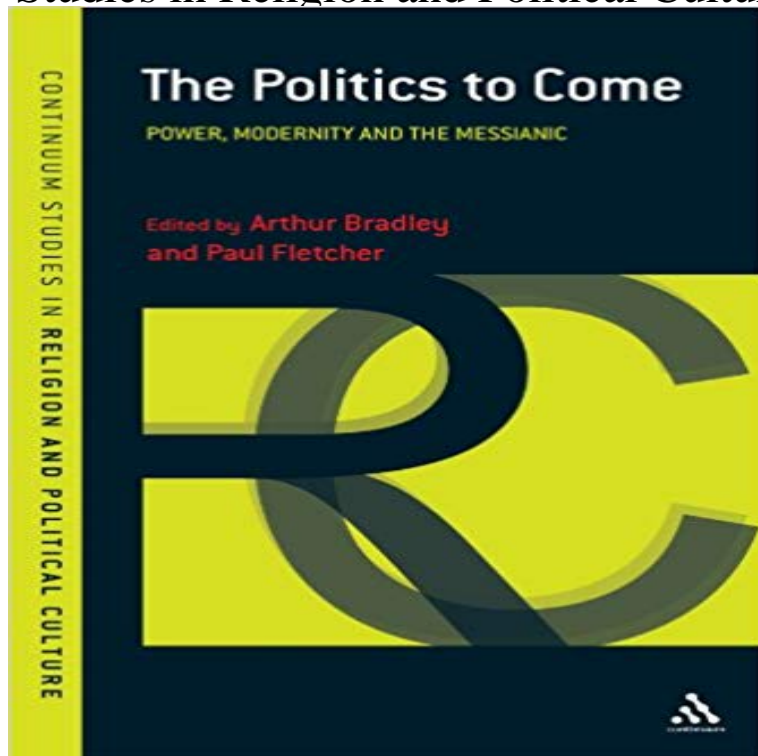


# Politics to Come: Power, Modernity and the Messianic (Continuum Studies in Religion and Political Culture)

This collection offers a series of political, philosophical and theological perspectives from which the future of liberal modernity - if it has one - can be imagined.
