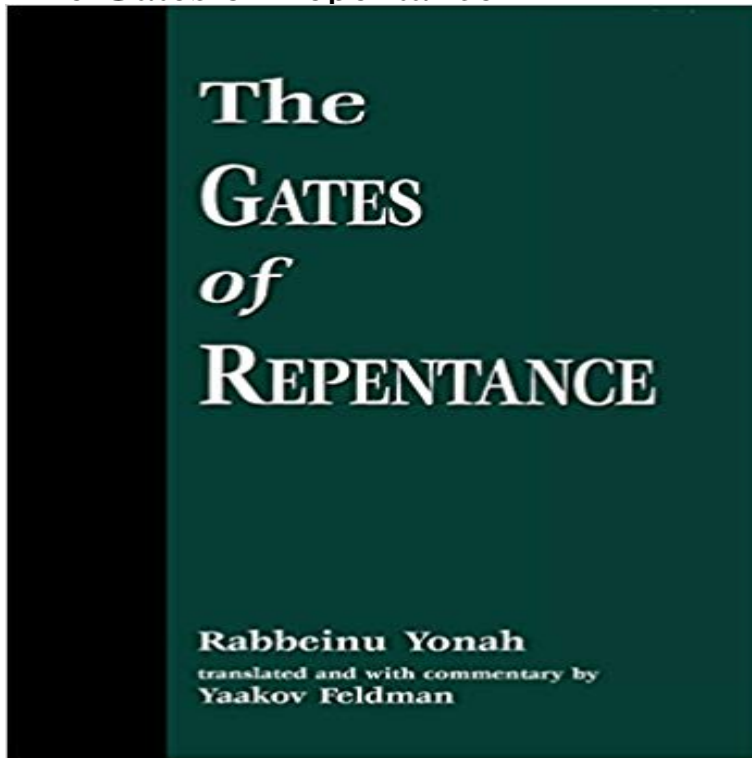


The Gates of Repentance
