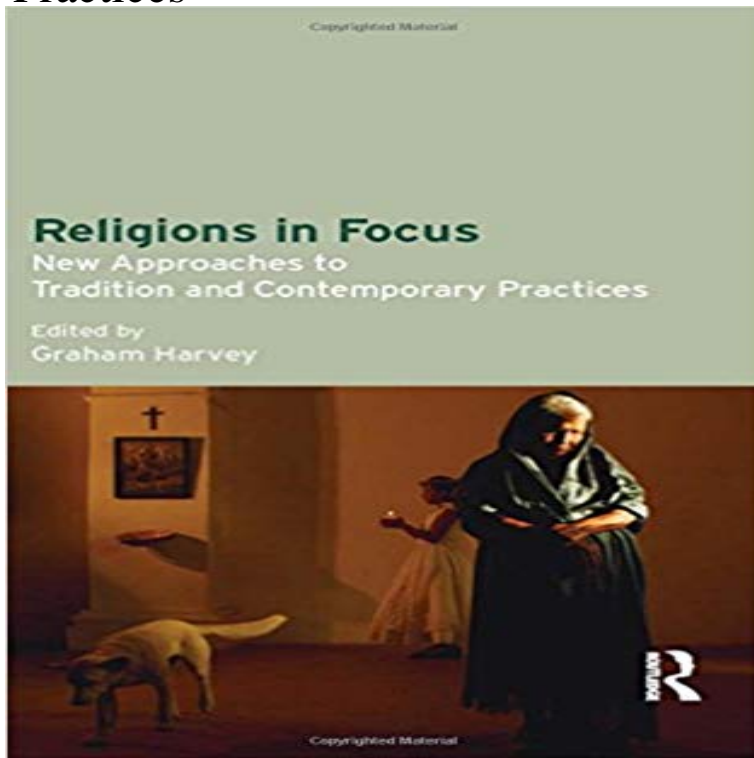


# Religions in Focus: New Approaches to Tradition and Contemporary Practices
