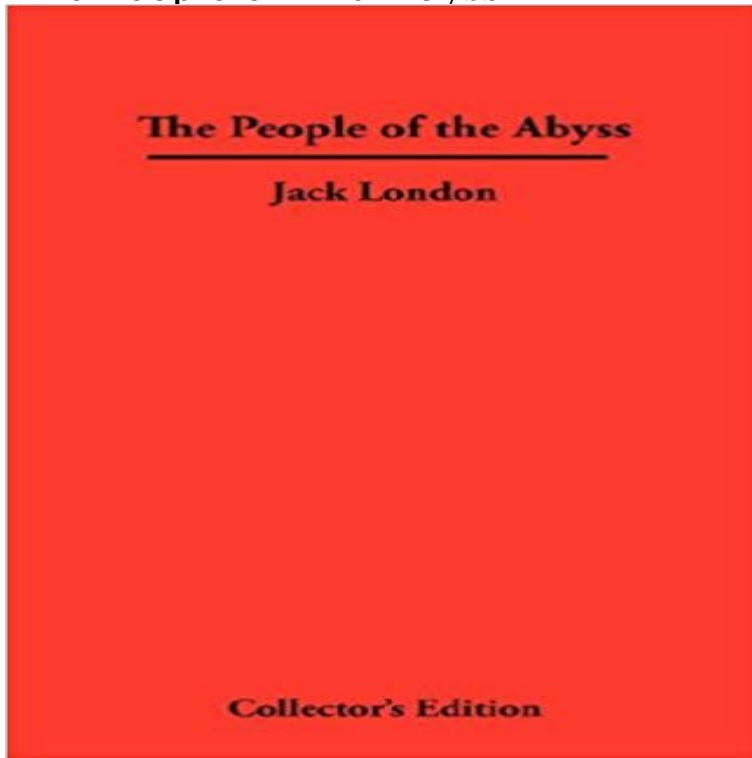


The People of The Abyss
