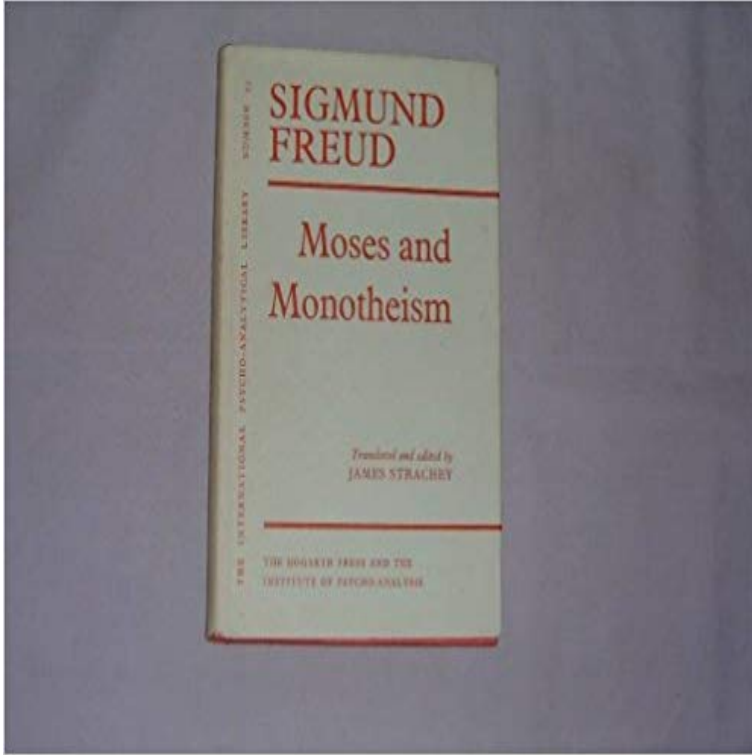


Moses and Monotheism (International Psycho-Analysis Library)
