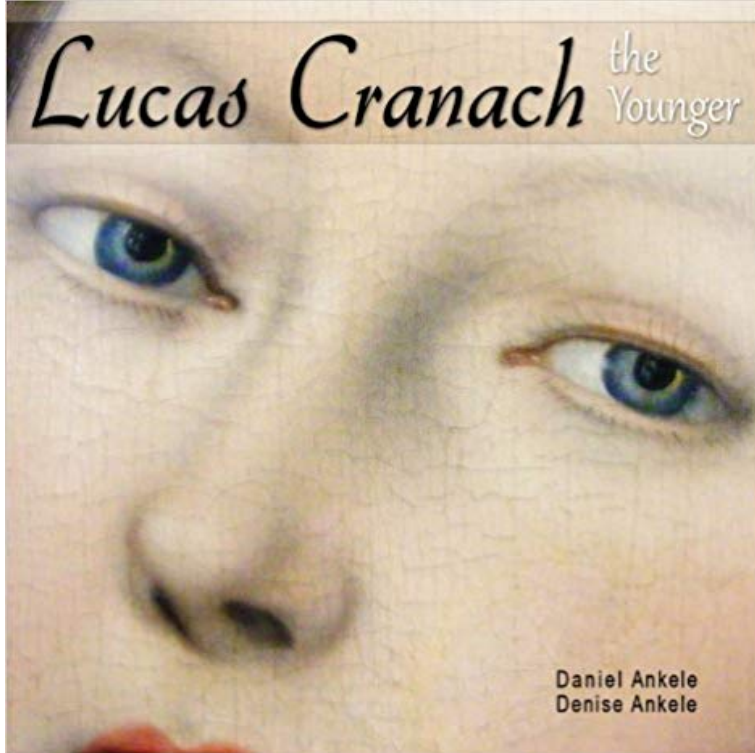

Cranach the Younger's painting style was so similar to his father's, there have been challenges in the attribution of their works. He followed in his father's footsteps serving in high civic office. First as a Wittenberg City Councilman, then Chancellor, and finally appointed as Burgomaster. NOTABLE WORKS: Christ as the Man of Sorrows, Adam and Eve, Hunt in Honour of Charles V, Portrait of Philip Melancthon.
