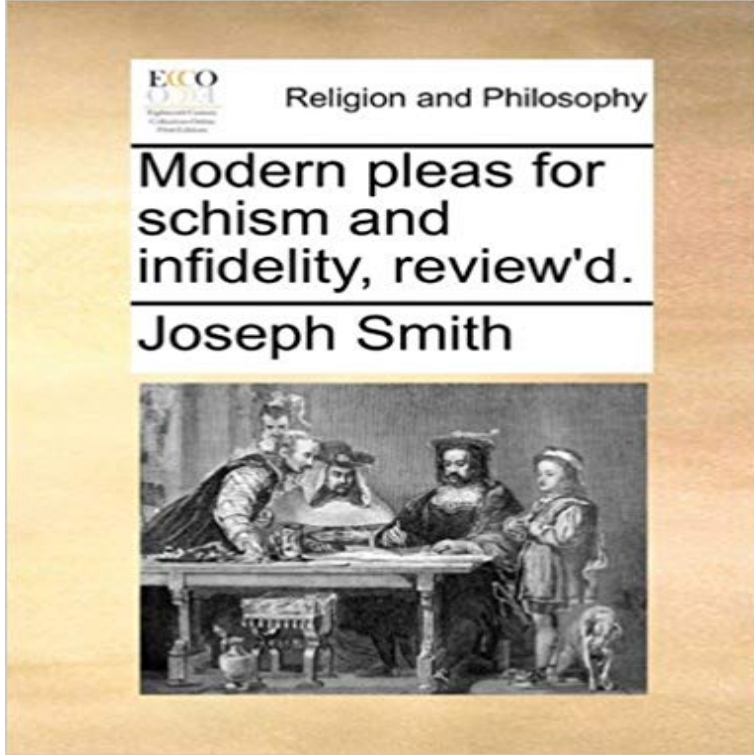


Modern pleas for schism and infidelity, review'd.
