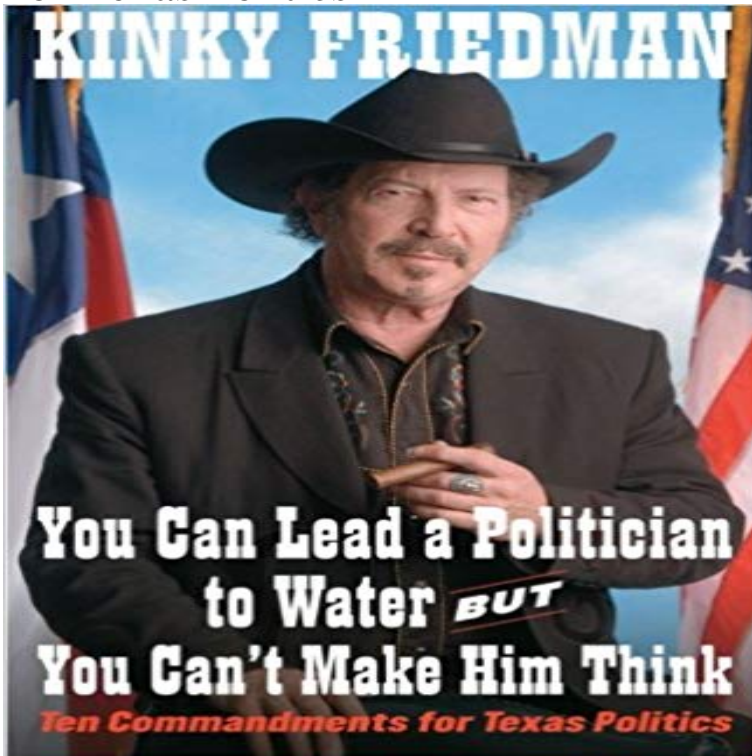


# You Can Lead a Politician to Water, But You Cant: Ten Commandments for Texas Politics
